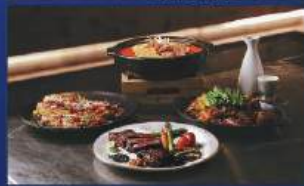

**Recommended dishes** include salmon head in sukiyaki sauce, fresh sea urchin, grilled cheese sweet potato cakes, and deep-fried oysters.

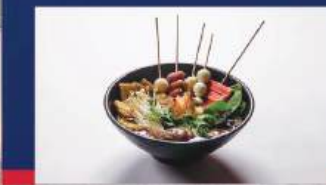

## 9.81 Park Smart Gravity Racing & Theme Park

A FUTURISTIC racing and entertainment destination in Aewol-eup, Jeju City.

Built around Jeju's natural terrain, the park offers gravity-powered racing experiences alongside panoramic views of the sea and mountains.

The venue also features around 15 indoor interactive attractions, including laser tag, sports simulation labs, AR shooting, and bumper cars.

- One-day pass: KRW 30,000 – 100,000 (depending on game mix)
- Standard full-package: around KRW 47,000
